The time for the party

How long the party will last should also be written in invitations. That can tell your guests when to arrive. It can make them better plan their own time.

Other information

If you’re planning a party outdoors, you should consider the weather first. No one wants to have a party in the bad weather. Be sure the weather is fine to make people comfortable.

Writing an invitation is important for a party. With a good invitation, people will enjoy themselves at the party.

If you’re working to become better or hoping to make a change, you’ll probably hear your family and friends say “go big or go home”. They think you should set high expectations (期待). But is it really good?

Having high expectations could be good. It can motivate you. When you have high expectations for something, you’ll probably try your best to make them come true. For example, if you believe that you can get an “A” in a test, you will probably spend a lot of time working on it. Also, when you start meeting your expectations, you’ll set even higher expectations for yourself. Besides, having high expectations on yourself doesn’t only do you good. It will make a difference to others.

But if your expectations are too high to realize, it can be bad. Having high expectations can sometimes lead to mind problems, such as worry and unhappiness. The findings of a study showed that some students were under serious stress (压力) because they wanted to be perfect. Great expectations can also let you down. This is especially true when you set expectations on other people whose actions you cannot control. For example, if you’re feeling alone and you call up your friends, you surely expect them to make you feel better. When this fails to happen, you will feel down and unsatisfied with your friends. To avoid this situation, you should set your expectations realistically (切合实际地).

It is hard to manage expectations, but the main thing is to set a more realistic and achievable expectation.

ChatGPT is a powerful chat robot developed by OpenAI. The company has introduced a new language model: GPT-4.

On March 14, GPT-4 showed the world how smarter it is than GPT-3. 5. It can understand pictures. For example, if you show a picture of a phone using the wrong charger (充电器), GPT-4 can tell why the picture is strange or funny.

GPT-4 can code (用代码编写) games and produce the code for a website based on a hand-made drawing. It can also change the style (样式) if you ask it to do that. GPT-4 is much better than the older GPT at passing tests.

GPT-4 will also be used as a tool to power other apps and services. For example, the language learning app Duolingo plans to use GPT-4. Users can learn languages by talking with AI. Another app, Be My Eyes, will have a digital assistant (数字助手) to help blind people better understand the world around them. As the Icelandic language is at risk, the government of Iceland plans to use GPT-4 to protect it.

However, there are still problems with GPT-4. It can’t get completely correct answers, especially with newer information after September 2021. GPT-4 also sometimes “hallucinates (产生幻觉)”. It will be sure that wrong information is true.

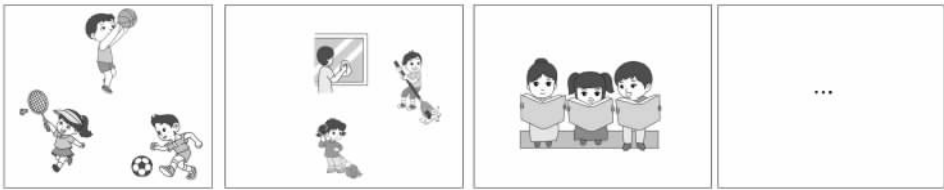
